Glendale Golf & Country Club Sponsored Junior Program

Thank you for your interest in the sponsored junior program.

The Sponsored Junior Selection process involves two stages:

- 1 *Preliminary Information Request – Submitted no later than March 14th*
- 2 *Personal Interview*

The Glendale Golf & Country Club Junior Selection Committee will contact prospective applicants no later than March 18th to advise whether or not they will be invited in for an interview.

Guidelines and Expectations:

- ✎ A person aged 15 – 18 as of August 8 of that golf season can apply to be a sponsored junior.
- ✎ Sponsor junior application forms can be picked up at the general office after February 1 for the upcoming golf season. Juniors applying for the first time must include a letter of introduction from their primary sponsor as well as from themselves. The applicant's letter should include past golf accomplishments, current handicap index, academic standing & achievements and aspirations both on a golfing and personal level. A copy of their most recent report card must be included and a letter from a coach or teacher should also be included.
- ✎ Completed forms must be returned no later than March 14th. Interviews with perspective Sponsored Juniors will take place within 10 days with the Junior Chairperson, Tee Time Management Chairperson and the Club Professional.
- ✎ Sponsored Juniors will be expected to complete twenty (20) hours of volunteer work at one of the Club Championships or within one of the practice areas.
- ✎ Returning Sponsored Juniors who have maintained their good standing shall receive first preference for subsequent years.
- ✎ A maximum of ten applicants will be approved per season.
- ✎ Sponsored Juniors must be an active participant of the Junior program.
- ✎ Applicants should have an average grade of 70%, have volunteered in some capacity, have played golf for at least three seasons and shown steady improvement to their game in this time.
