The Board of Directors of the Glendale Golf & Country Club has set out the following policies by which all Tournaments are to be operated under:

- **In the spirit of operating one of the finest golf courses in Canada, the Glendale’s Members and guests are expected to observe high standards of social etiquette to foster an environment conducive to the enjoyment of the Club’s wonderful facilities and the comfort of other Members and their guests. The Glendale has a strict dress code, which does not permit blue jeans in the Clubhouse or on the Golf Course and prohibits the wearing of any type of visor or cap in the Clubhouse.**
- **The Members of the Glendale Golf & Country Club have imposed a four hour and fifteen minute guideline for day-to-day play that is monitored. Further to this, all tee-time tournaments must be complete in four hours and thirty minutes or less and we require that all shotgun tournaments be complete in five hours or less. An on-course Marshall will be monitoring play during your tournament please follow any instructions that they may have for your group and know that they are there for the assistance and enjoyment of all golfers.**
- **The Glendale Golf & Country Club is a “spikeless” facility. Accordingly, all of the players in your tournament will be required to wear an alternative to metal spiked golf shoes. Please ensure that you advise all participants of this requirement. The Glendale Pro Shop does presently have facilities to change golf shoes from spikes to soft spike; however, due to day to daytime constraints we cannot guarantee the availability of that service.**
- **A \$ 1,000.00 deposit must be paid to secure your booking. This is a non-refundable deposit, except in the event of inclement weather and the course is deemed unplayable. (All efforts will be made to accommodate an alternate date in the case of a “rain-out”).**
- **The Tournament organizer shall assume responsibility for any and all damages resulting from the tournament. The organizer is responsible for proper conduct of all participants.**
- **Under the guidelines in which our liquor license is granted, the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission does not permit any donated or supplied liquor to be brought onto golf course premises. All liquor that is required for on-course consumption must be purchased at cost plus 15% through our Food & Beverage Manager Amber McCroary We have been instructed to confiscate any illegal liquor or risk the possibility of forfeiting our liquor license.**

Enclosed please find a “**Tournament Requirement Form**” to assist you with tabulating any requirements that you may have on the golf course. Please fill out the areas that apply to your tournament and send the sheet back to us at least one week prior to your event so that we are better able to assist with the set-up of the golf course.
